This is a brief overview of public proceedings during a scheduled Meeting of the Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy (NSBMT) regarding the NSBMT's actions that affect its licensees and the profession of massage therapy, reflexology, and structural integration in Nevada. Disciplinary hearings and/or Items and Public Comment are not a part of this report.

- Item #14a: The board has about \$184,000 in reserves, above their operations' costs (budget & actual), so they are secure.
- Item #14b: The 2018 Budget was approved without Board vote since no projections for operational costs have changed or were added/removed.
- Item #14c: The board voted to send 6 people to FARB Forum in CA in Jan 2018 at a total cost of about \$2,500/person - this training is regulatory training for the new board member replacing the resigning one, the 2 new Inspectors, and Board members refreshing their knowledge.
- Item #15: a) July's and b) August's Minutes were approved.
- Item #16: Inspection Team reported they are caught up with scheduled inspections, through September 2017.
- Item #17, 18: The board voted to have a special meeting of the NSBMT in a workshop to take Public Comment regarding this meeting's Agenda Items #17, #18, & #19: the reflexology, structural integration components of AB179's Passing, and more specifics about the ethics (law) questions proposed to be asked of each Renewing NSBMT Licensee - it will take place on December 13, 2017. A representative from both the Commission on Post-Secondary Education in NV and from the Wynn came by for clarification and support of the draft of the Massage Therapy NACs that will be voted on/into the NACs November 29, 2017. Pending any serious problems, the LCB-approved draft (that the representatives referred to today) will be codified upon the NSBMT's Approval.
- Item #19: additionally (to above notes): RE: Massage Therapists: The resultant Draft of August 16th's Meeting/[Public]Workshop have been sent to LCB and are awaiting return so that the NSBMT can vote them into the NACs, at the November 29, 2017, Meeting.
