Bianca Smith reported on her Basic CLEAR training [outcome] and thanked the Board for sending her to TX last week for the training - Sandy Anderson, Executive Director (ED) indicated that when her year was served using her Basic training, she would be enrolled in Advanced training ASAP.

Policies in place (for Interim Ed, the Southern Nevada Operations Manager would serve, first) determine the organizational structure in the case the ED is temporarily unable to attend to his/her duties, including signing and spending authority.

Item #17: The Board was advised by the ED that she will be working on the Board Policy Manual to finalize a first draft for distribution & discussion by next Meeting in June. Currently, about 100 pages are completed, but cooperative effort is still needed and planned with Staff/Committee Members to finalize a draft version for discussion/approval by the Board.
