This is a brief overview of public proceedings during a scheduled Meeting of the Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy (NSBMT) regarding the NSBMT's actions that affect its licensees, the profession of massage therapy, reflexology, and structural integration, and the Public in Nevada. Item #1: Called to order at 9:04am, all Board Members accounted for.

Item #2: To date, no new Board member(s) are appointed.

Items #4-22: The Board heard 3 cases of sexual assault, accepted 1 voluntary surrender, and revoked 2 licenses for 10 years. The Board heard 12 cases of solicitation, accepted 10 voluntary surrenders, revoked 1 license for 10 years and continued 1 case until the January 8, 2019 meeting. The Board heard 1 appeal for an unlicensed activity citation and upheld the citation.

Item #23: Consent Agenda Approved for sub-items a.-d. Clarification of sub-item e., then Approval.

Item #24: Certificate of Deposit liquid assets (as they have matured) of ~\$413,000 were Approved to be reinvested into a market-competitive 18-month CD w/ an approximate rate of return at 1.8% with JP Morgan/Chase. This is a good part of the Reserves the Board carries annually, the total Reserve amount being approximately \$1.2M.

Item #25: Board agreed 2 staff/members should attend January 2020's FARB Meeting, based on the pertinent relevance of the offerings. Attendees are expected to report upon their return.

Item #26: Northern NV Counsel has some cases and projects in order, but will be vacating her position with the NSBMT (as appointed AG Counsel) as of November 15, 2019. A new Northern NV attorney will be assigned, maybe by the end of 2019. Southern NV Counsel and Counsel Intern remains.

Item #27:

- a. North and South Inspection Teams targeted to complete 100% of inspections by end of year.
- b. Criminal cases need to resolve [in criminal court] before NSBMT hears disciplinary cases, otherwise: criminal cases may be decided differently



based on NSBMT (administrative, not criminal) decisions/action. Las Vegas Metro Police Department is making approximately 2-4 arrests in NSBMT-Establishments every week.

- c. Year-To-Date: ~600 licenses have been issued. SoNV Office: low visit-percentage - schools have been reached out to, informing of existence of SoNV Office location, services, etc, and several ideas were introduced by Board members about how to increase public/professionals' awareness of the office & its services. During an unusually tight year, Budget has improved from an approx-\$630K deficit to an approx-\$551K deficit - next Budget-year will see substantial improvement to P&L figures.

Add'l reporting:

Polaris conference - the Polaris organization hosted the Executive Director's attendance. A striking situation that all states are struggling with is that there is a lack of local organizations to pull victims out of trafficking scenarios. FSMTB: a massage-only organization of state-Regulators of massage therapy laws, the Board discussed it's continued participation in this priority, experience-based organization: networking and building continuous, long-standing relationships with other Board members and State-office Staff is important to the massage therapy profession in Nevada.
